We are the Cornish theatre behind the much-loved stage adaptation of **The Mousehole Cat**. This Easter we were intending to stage our brandnew show based on the locally written children's book, **Percy Pengelly and the Wibble-Wobble**. When this wasn't able to go ahead we changed tack and created a free-to-watch, filmed, audiobook (from our homes) of the original story performed with "live" music for children and their families.

# **Using "Virtual Percy" for Literacy Home Learning**

Chris Parker, a teacher from Nancledra School near Penzance designed a literacy task around Percy's story (he doesn't mind us sharing it with you!) Children use each episode of "Virtual Percy" as a stimulus to write their own chapter of the story - this could be written independently, with a parent or even as a comic strip. We have also created some additional videos with "messages of encouragement" from the story's characters.

# **How Chris did it...** Setting up the task (Monday)

Write the story of Percy Pengelly in three parts. This week write Chapter 1 using Episode 1, of Virtual Percy, at Cousin Jacks:

Using the 'Virtual Percy' story provided by Cousin Jacks, I would like you to re-write the story 'Percy Pengelly and the Wibble-Wobble'.

Introduce the character Percy Pengelly and his job as a tightrope walker. Next, he is told to leave the circus. Then, he tries three jobs, all smelly. You don't have to write down every bit, just the important parts to create a great story.

#### **Encouragement Email (Thursday)**

I know that writing at home, for some, can be hard work so I want to make this as easy and creative as possible. Over the next three weeks of writing the story of Percy Pengelly I would like you to feel free in how you write it. Children can write it as a story completely independently or they may want to do it as a joint effort with someone in their family. Alternatively you could even do it as a comic strip with pictures of the story as it unfolds. Your choice!

The following Monday Chris sent out Episode Two. On Wednesday he sent out "Hello from Mrs Roskilly" and on Thursday he sent "Encouragement from Captain Lugg".

For the final week he sent out Episode Three on Monday. On Wednesday he sent out "Encouragement from Mrs Trewin" on the Thursday he sent out "Encouragement from Percy Pengelly".
